Organ and Choir

The organ is a Victorian pipe organ with 2 manuals and pedals, and was last rebuilt in 1950. It is regularly played at Sunday services.



The choir is affiliated to the Royal School of Church Music and is currently comprised of ladies and girls, but men and boys are most welcome to join! The choir usually sings at the 9:30am service on Sundays and practices on Thursday evenings. Choir robes consist of a dark red cassock and white surplice with a ruff for ladies and junior choristers. Medals are awarded for passing singing assessments or for services to the choir.

If you would like to join the choir, you are welcome to visit us on a Thursday evening at our practice in church between 7.30pm and 8.30pm.

Wedding Music

The organ and choir can provide all of the music required in church before, during and after your wedding service:

- The organist can play music for the bride's entrance, hymns, during the signing of the register and when you process out, and can accompany your own singers if required.
- The choir can sing an anthem during the signing of the register as well as leading the singing of hymns.

The Organist/Choirmaster will advise and discuss with you your choice of music, hymns and anthem at least 4 weeks before your wedding.

The fees for 2012 are £90 for the organist and £90 for the choir, both are payable in cash or via PayPal at least 2 weeks before the wedding.
