Eternal Father, whose Son Jesus Christ ascended to the throne of heaven that he might rule over all things as Lord and King: keep the Church in the unity of the Spirit and in the bond of peace, and bring the whole created order to worship at his feet; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.



Daniel Chapter 7 verses 9-10,13,14

As I watched, thrones were set in place, and an Ancient One took his throne; his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames, and its wheels were burning fire. ¹⁰ A stream of fire issued and flowed out from his presence. A thousand thousand served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood attending him. The court sat in judgement, and the books were opened. ¹³As I watched in the night visions, I saw one like a human being coming with the clouds of heaven. And he came to the Ancient One and was presented before him. ¹⁴ To him was given dominion and glory and kingship, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not pass away, and his kingship is one that shall never be destroyed.

John Chapter 18 verses 33 - 37

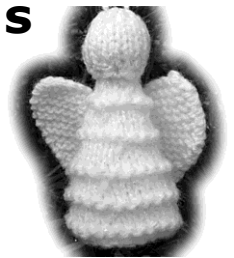

Afghanistan, the Taliban and other groups

A Talk by Dr Chris Hewer on Tuesday 23rd November 7:00 - 9:00pm at the Central Methodist Church, Saltergate, Chesterfield S401UH

What is going on in Afghanistan?

To understand the situation as it is developing today, we need to go back and understand the geography and history of outside involvement in Afghanistan. We hear much about the Taliban but what is their history and how do they fit in? Then we hear about the involvement of international groups like Al-Qaida and an affiliate of the so-called Islamic State. How are they linked around the world and how do they relate to the Taliban?

Dr Chris Hewer is a Christian who comes from a background in Christian theology, education, Islamic studies and inter-faith studies. He has worked in the field of Muslims in Britain and Christian-Muslim relations since 1986, including 6 years as Advisor on Inter-Faith Relations to the Bishop of Birmingham. His current work is to teach study days and residential courses, and to develop written and electronic resources. His book 'A Short Guide to Understanding Islam' has been published by a London mosque to be given to non-Muslims wanting to learn about Islam, whilst he was invited by a Muslim TV channel to produce a 46 part series of half hour programmes on Understanding Islam. Winter Homeless Provision in Chesterfield

From 1st Dec 2021 until 31st March 2022 the Local Authorities are providing Bed & Breakfast accommodation across the County - there will not be a charity-led Nightshelter. **Church from the Bus** (who are based at Grace Chapel), intend to offer a daily hot evening meal throughout this time, and also provide space to relax and build relationships before people return to their Bed and Breakfast accommodation. They are working on the possibility of some lunchtime provision as well.
