

Wedding Music

The organ, electronic piano, recorded music and choir can provide all of the music required in church before, during and after your **wedding or service of blessing**.



You will need music for the bride's entrance, hymns, during the signing of the marriage document and when you process out, and perhaps to accompany your own singers.

You may also arrange to have your own singers or musicians.

Organ & Piano

At least 4 weeks before your wedding you will need to discuss your choice of music, hymns and anthem with your organist, who can also offer advice.

Recorded Music

If using our sound system, please provide someone to operate it, and it is advisable for them to practice using it beforehand, such as at your rehearsal.

Choir

It may be possible (subject to availability) to provide a choir, which can lead the singing of hymns.

Fees & Booking

The fees are:

- £130 for the organ or piano to be played (and recorded music)
- £65 for recorded music only
- £120 for the choir

all payable at least 4 weeks before your wedding or blessing.
